- Mandla & Dindori districts of Madhya Pradesh
- Predominantly Tribal area

- Rice is the main crop. Kodo & Little Millets are grown in the upland. Pulses, maize, vegetables are other crops
- Average rainfall is about 1100 mm
- Project is working 30 villages, approx. 2700 families, all smallholders

Activity : Onfarm Networking

STATUS

- Before project farmers were cultivating Millet crops in traditional ways with their seeds.
- 2796 Households given proper training through 120 training sessions with support of RARS (Millet, Dindori Station)
- The training & exposure increased farmers' capacity to adopt improved PoP, new verities
- Higher productivity recorded





Activity : Ex situ & in situ linkages

STATUS

- Participatory Trials conducted for 6 varieties of Kodo millets
- Couple of varieties clearly identified as farmers' preferred

Activity : Onfarm Networking

STATUS

150 custodian farmers identified & trained

S. Salaria

- Selection done through FGDs, knowledge sharing, Millet conservation, holding stock of Millets
- Custodian farmers got exposure to scientific process of Millet conservation with technical support of Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK)
- Exposure visit to Kolli Hills, ITM also provided better learning to the custodian farmers





Activity: Document monitoring

Establishing the practice of maintaining village biodiversity register

STATUS

- Training by MPSBB to SHG members & staff, 17 Master Trainers from community developed, refresher course done.
- 95 SHGs covering 1235 farmer families have been trained by the Master Trainer
- 6 Biodiversity Management Committee at village level have been formed, started functioning; 5 more are under formation





Activity : Document monitoring

STATUS

- Biodiversity register is under revision by the State Govt., hence could not be started.
- Will be initiated from 2nd Year of Project

Activity: Red List

Preparation of Red List through participatory method

STATUS

Identification of Red List has been completed & included in the baseline report

- Farmers have been trained on the crops and varieties of the Red list
- Herbarium Album of all Millet crops for the project area has been developed and being used as training material





Activity : Value Chain

Activity : Development & nurturing of Farmers' company for value chain

STATUS

3 FPCs having 2642 shareholders, majority women

- Produced about 800 quintals of Millet seeds (Foundation, Certified & TL); being marketed currently
- Bigger plan of seed production for 2016-17





Activity : Value Chain

STATUS

 On a pilot scale 2000 quintals of Kodo & Little millets have been procured by the FPCs; to be sold in bigger market for better price realization

Contraction and Street and

- Due to this marketing strategy the local price of millets has gone up benefitting farmers
- Detailed marketing strategy is being worked out for larger scale from next year
- Grading & processing facilities being developed at the FPCs level
- Electronic marketing platform is being explored for all India market





Activity : Value Chain

STATUS

 Price information of different markets to farmers thru SMS is being worked out

- Organic cultivation of millets to capture premium market segment
- Possibilities of entering market with processed Kodo & kutki millets is being worked out





Activity : Policy options

STATUS

• Few policy notes have been prepared to share with the critical policy makers

- National conference in Bhopal in May'16 is fully focused on sensitizing policy makers on issues related to NUS, particularly Kodo & kutki millets
- Expecting few policy measures by the Government,
 - declaring Kodo & kutki as notified crops in the regulated market yard
 - Provisioning of Breeder seeds to the FPCs for high quality seed production
 - Initiating Agronomy related research by the State Agriculture University
